Eligibility Criteria for Radboud University Scholarshi

To be eligible for Radboud University Masters Scholarship, students have to meet the given below criteria:

- A candidate must hold a passport that is not issued by the European Union or the European Economic Area. –
- A bachelor's degree from a country other than the Netherlands is required. –
- A candidate must not hold a Dutch academic qualification or degree. –
- Aspirants must be able to communicate in the English language. –
- Before September 1, 2023, a candidate must be enrolled in an English–taught Master's program at Radboud University. –
- A candidate must be committed to pursuing a degree full–time. –
- Students should be highly ambitious and talented. –
- A candidate must have a good academic record. –
- A candidate should present letters of recommendation that are of high quality. –
- In his letter of motivation, an applicant should express his excitement for the master's program. –

Required Documents:

Students have to prepare the following documents to apply for Radboud University Masters Scholarship 2023–24 in Netherland:

- Two letters of recommendation –
- Curriculum vitae (CV) –
- Admission to a master's program and selection for the Radboud Scholarship are two separate processes; acceptance to a master's program does not guarantee selection for the scholarship. –
- Through this grant, a student will apply for both fully funded and partially funded scholarships. –

Application Procedure for Radboud University Masters Scholarsh

By indicating your interest in a Radboud University Masters Scholarship 2023–24 during your application for admission to a Master’s degree via the OSIRIS Application system, you can apply for a Radboud Scholarship. You’ll be requested to upload three more documents after that; two reference letters and your curriculum vitae. You can use these documents for your scholarship application if you previously uploaded them for your Master’s program application.

Scholarship selection and admission to the Master’s program are two separate processes; scholarship selection is not required for admission to the Master’s program. Please note that applications that are not complete will not be accepted for the Radboud Scholarship. Some information and/or papers are missing or illegible in an incomplete application. We suggest that you submit your proof of English competence before the deadline.
